The basic idea of **Community Supported Agriculture*** is that a farmer grows for a group of members who have purchased "shares" in the harvest. Members pay at the beginning of the season in March, when the farmer most needs the money. When the crops start coming in June, the farmer delivers a weekly assortment of vegetables, herbs and some fruit. This is not a coop, there are no wholesalers or distributors. 100% of your food dollars go to the person who is growing it. You support sustainable local agriculture and get freshly picked organic produce at reasonable prices. In addition, you know the farmer growing your vegetables and can visit the farm -establishing a personal connection with your food supply.

The cost of a Full Share will be \$575.00 for 12 Pick-ups.

(12 bi-weekly deliveries over a 24 week period)

A share is enough vegetables for 4 people. (1 Bushel Box)

In the early season there will typically be selections of peas, kale, arugula, spinach, lettuce, escarole, turnips, parsnips cilantro, basil, dill, parsley, etc. As the season progresses tomatoes, peppers, eggplant, squash, corn, onions, carrots, beans, beets, etc will be added.

Tentative varieties planned for the upcoming season include: Arugula, Asian Greens, Baby Green, Basil, Beans, Beets, Broccoli, Broccoli Raab, Brussell Sprouts, Cabbage, Carrots, Celery, Chard, Corn, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Garlic, Herbs, Kale, Leeks, Lettuce, Melons, Micro Greens, Onions, Parsnips, Peas, Peppers, Pumpkins, Radishes,

Please Read Carefully before submitting your application and payment:

- I understand that as a **Bracco Farms CSA** member I share in the risks and rewards of farming. Thus, there is no guarantee as to the amount of produce that I will receive. **The variety, quantity and duration may vary according to the weather and the time of year.
- I understand that there are no refunds for shares in the event of a natural disaster.
- I understand that I am purchasing a share of one (1) season's harvest and not ownership of the farm, the property, or equipment.
- I will arrive at the designated distribution point at the designated time to pick up my share. If I cannot pick up my share due to an non-emergency (such as vacation), I will provide one week notice and may be allowed to make up a share depending on availability. Make up shares will be available in emergency situations. I will attempt to give notice of my inability to pick up due to an emergency as soon as I am able. An alternate pick up date may also be available in emergency situations. If I do not pick my share on the designated date, I may be able to pick it up on the next day at the farm. Shares will not be available for pick up after that time unless previous arrangements have been made.
